



# Comberton Community Swimming Club

## MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM 2011 SEASON

Pool Opens Sat 14<sup>th</sup> May

Comberton Community Swimming Club (CCSC) operates throughout the summer months at the Village College Comberton outdoor pool. The pool is heated to a minimum of 27°C and is a family-friendly community facility. The club runs successfully due to the commitment of its members who give their time to run the sessions. One adult member from each family provides help as either a First Safety Officer, a Second Safety Officer or an Administrator.

A First Safety officer and Second Safety Officer provide pool safety cover while two Administrators oversee entry to the pool and clean up after the session. Sessions are usually two hours long.

First Safety Officers must qualify for RLSS Life Support 1 AND have our own CCSC First Safety Officer qualification. These qualifications must be current and are valid for two years after which the individual must re-qualify.

NEW FIRST SAFETY OFFICER TRAINING WILL TAKE PLACE IN MAY/JUNE THIS YEAR. **We urge members who are competent swimmers to please consider taking the training for First Safety Officer** – not only will it help the club, but you will learn, free of charge, some very valuable skills. For details of training see page 2 of this application.

Second Safety Officers need no special qualification, only to attend the annual 2 hour training/refresher session, dates for which are shown on the second page of this application. **We urge members who are competent swimmers to please consider volunteering for Second Safety Officer.**

Administrators should have knowledge of their duties as set out on page 9 of the club rule book.

All members should be familiar with the club rules (copies available from membership secretary) and sign the declaration.

**The Family Membership Fee, covering all members of one family are £45 per family for new members and £45 for existing members renewing before 8<sup>th</sup> April as detailed below. The fee for late renewals is £55. Single Adult Membership is £35 for new members/prompt renewals and £45 for late renewals.** If you would like to make an additional donation to club funds, please enter amount here £ ..... and include it in your cheque.

CCSC relies on your help to run the club. One adult member from each family must provide help as either a First Safety Officer, a Second Safety Officer or an Administrator. Safety Officers are typically rostered for 5-7 duties unless he/she offers more. Administrators are typically rostered for 2/3. **We urge competent swimmers to please volunteer for Second Safety Officer for which no special qualifications are required or to take the training for First Safety Officer.**

First Safety Officers Require **RLSS Life Support 1 and CCSC Water Safety Qualification to be taken in May/June 2011 OR: National Pool Lifeguard Qualification (obtained in last two years)**

Second Safety Officers Must attend one of the club training/refresher sessions held in April/May – see below

Administrators No training required but must be familiar with the club rules & your duties.
