Because of this, the Exceptional Funding Support has been established with the aim of providing financial assistance.

Young people are only eligible to claim once for EFS.

Grants have a maximum value of £100

Grants are for domestic (British) trips only.

To obtain support **Part A should be completed by the parent** to give evidence of a clear financial need. This must include at least one of the following bullet points below:

- Be a young person in care
- Be a disabled young person in receipt of Disability Living Allowance.
- Eligible for Free School Meals
- From a household whose income is below £20817 per annum
- Been affected by a sudden exceptional change in financial circumstances

In addition **Part B should be completed by the student** and submitted with the application for funding.
