At KS4 pupils can access a broad range of DT options with our suite of courses; WJEC Level 1 & 2 Award in Hospitality and Catering, AQA GCSE Graphic Design, OCR Cambridge Nationals Engineering Design and WJEC Level 1 & 2 Constructing the Built Environment. Alongside this the Food Technology department has run a successful enrichment programme for students in the sixth form which could be continued in the future. The DT department prides itself on the accessibility and appeal of its courses for pupils of all abilities. The department consistently achieves outcomes that are significantly above average.

The successful candidate will be responsible for managing all aspects of delivering an exciting and imaginative Food Technology Curriculum within the Technology department.
