Attendance

- We will inform you of your child's attendance regularly (via reports) and will contact you directly if we become concerned. Attendance to school is one the most important success criteria in terms of achievement at school.
- Punctuality is vital- please help your child to be at school on time. Two late marks leads to one lunch time detention.
- Planned absences- should be avoided on school days but should always be requested in advance via the absence request form online or are available from the Attendance Office. COM-Attendance@combertonvc.org



Absence

- Please phone the switchboard (01223 262503) or use the absence notification on website. On each day of absence, please provide a reason.
- Medical appts need to be emailed to com-attendance and the Tutor and missed work must be caught up with.
- If leaving the school for an appointment, sign out of school at the Attendance Office– work must be caught up on.
- Illness- if your child is ill in school, the nurse will contact you and ask you to collect them (pupils must not contact you directly).



Mobile Devices

- Leave at home if possible.
- Switched off during the day.
- Parents call the school switchboard if you need a message for your son/ daughter.
- No text or calls are allowed to be made during the school day.
- It is forbidden to photograph anyone in school or on the way to/from school
- School not liable in case of loss
