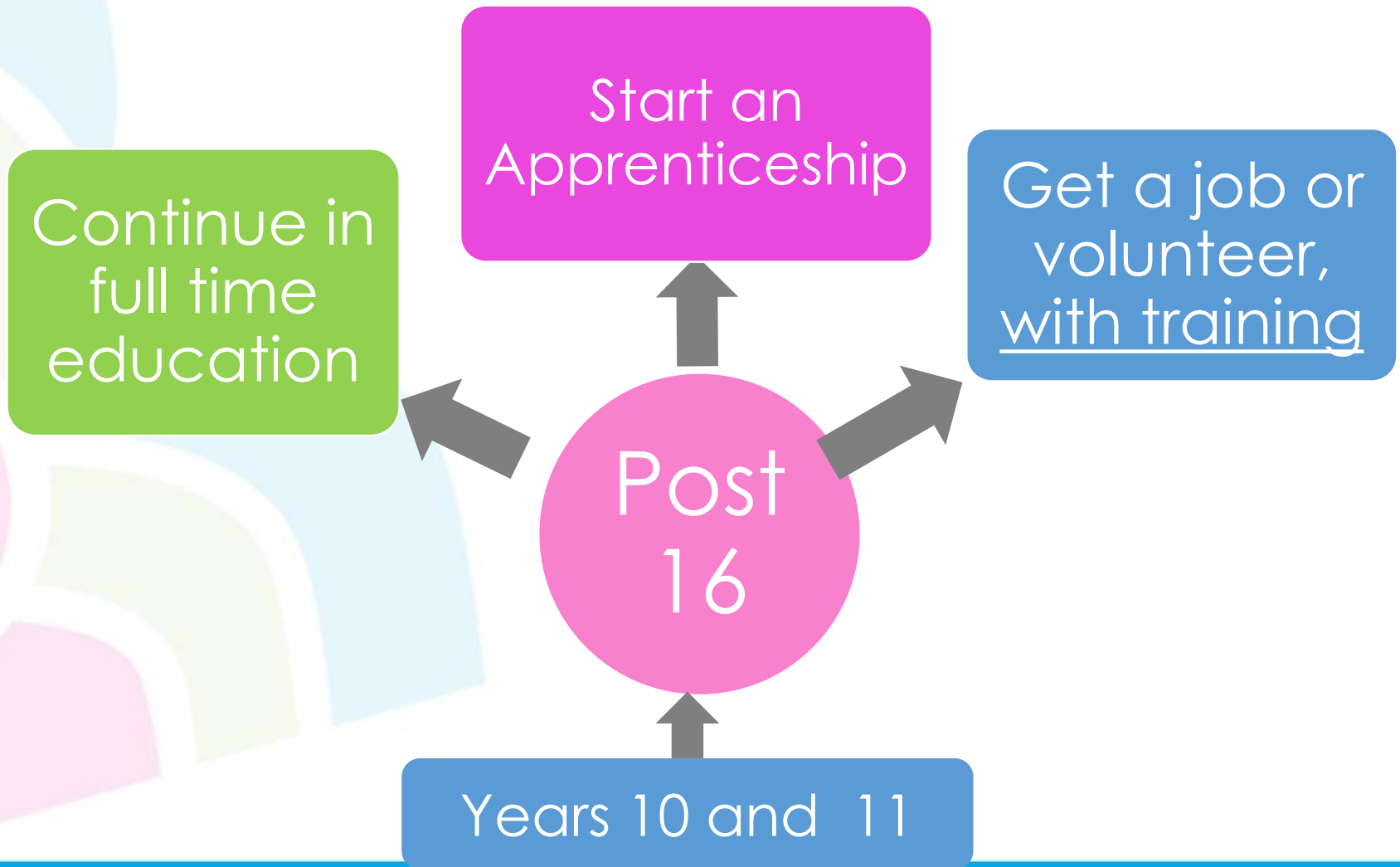

Applying for a job

Pupils will put their GCSE grades and other qualification on every job application they complete.

University

All GCSEs and level 2 qualifications are important.

- Universities look at them.
- Some university courses require at least 5 grade 7s at GCSE in addition to A-levels.
- Some science-based degree courses need at least grade 6 at GCSE.

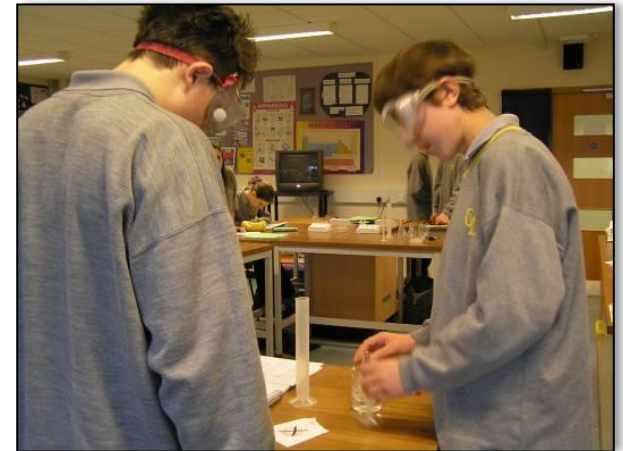
The Core Curriculum

Examined Core Subjects:

- English (language and literature)
- Maths
- Sciences (separate or combined)
- PE
- MFL (a choice)

Additional core subjects:

- PSHE
- Computing
- RPE
- Citizenship
- Work related learning



English+ (Step Up to English)

- Prepares selected pupils for the different demands of GCSE English Language and GCSE English Literature.
- English+ is **invitation only**.
- Pupils have been identified for the English+ groups based on their progress in English, their current attainment and available FFT data.
- A pupil may decide not to take up the offer of a place in an English+ group. They would, however, need to select an MFL option.
- Detailed information on the Step Up and GCSE courses is in the English area of our website.

MFL or English Plus

Pupils must choose one Modern Foreign Language except in exceptional circumstances.

- GCSE Spanish • GCSE French • GCSE German
- English + (by invitation only)



Science

Either separate sciences or combined science.

- 3 Separate sciences:
GCSE Biology, GCSE Chemistry and GCSE Physics
- 2 GCSEs in Combined Science



Key Stage 4 Options

Pupils must choose

two options (if planning to study separate sciences) or
three options (if planning to study combined science).

Pupils are generally able to study a second foreign language as an option.

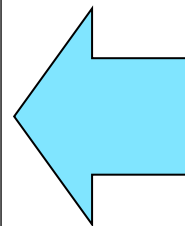
