Remote Learning: How to access your class and homework

Finding Your Work

All your learning is accessible through the <u>office.com</u> website. You need to sign in with your school username and password, which is the same as the one you use to login to school computers.

Set Homework Tasks

Go4Schools is where your teachers put your homework tasks and communicate with you. Access this through the Go4Schools mobile app or the go4schools.com website.

You are part of a 'Team' for each of your classes. Your teachers may use your class 'Team' to share class resources and you may be asked to upload homework here. Your teachers will make it clear to you how they expect you to submit work.

You should access your school email account daily. You do this through the Outlook link on the office.com homepage.
