Our pupils are well motivated, staff morale is excellent and examination results at KS4 are outstanding: 87% of students attained grades 9 – 4 in Maths and English last academic year and 43% of all grades were 9-7: whilst at A-level 87% of grades were A* - C, and 36% of all grades were A* - A. The Sixth Form's results are in the top 5% nationally for student progress made against predictors.

We are looking for someone who is passionate about Physical Education and the health and well-being of young people. Someone who will contribute to the outstanding teaching and learning within the PE department. The successful candidate needs to be hard working, an excellent practitioner who has initiative and good communication skills. We have an extensive extra-curricular programme which they will contribute to. There is potential for some leadership responsibility within the department for an appropriately experienced candidate.
