DT: Pupils are taught on a subject rotational basis, completing assessments within each block of DT at the appropriate time within the scheme they are following.

Drama - every half term there is a practical assessment and a written

progress takes place throughout the year.

Music: On average practical work is formally assessed once in each half term, however most music work forms part of a programme of continuous assessment which will sometimes take the place of a formal assessment. Pupils are assessed in theskill areas of appraising, composing, performing and music literacy.
