Year 6 iPads for Learning Scheme

iPads are leased:

- Voluntary parental contribution of no more than £11 per month for 36 months
- 8th generation iPad
- Insurance for the iPad
- Case and screen protector
- A range of apps provided and managed by the College, including Microsoft Office, and other approved apps
- Option to purchase the device at the end of the lease
